Pull the lever to release the legrest, the leg rest will elevate.

Depending on the clients leg weight some assistance may be needed to help elevate the legrest.

Pull the lever to release the legrest and push down the leg rest.





Pull the brake lever to release the Tilt in Space gas strut and tilt the client towards you. As this is a manual chair you will need to help control the movement and push down the handles.

To bring the chair back up again release the brake lever and tilt the chair forward helping to control the movment.





To set the back angle, hold the top rear handle and support it.

Then Pull the plastic pull-pin which will then release the angle bracket and select the angle you require and release the pull-pin. This will automaticly lock into place.









Adjustable Seat Depth

(First apply the brakes)

You can change the seat depth from 17" to 21". To change the seat depth, lift the velcroed down skirt up at the back of the chair and you will see the brake lever on the backrest bar. Hold the lower bar with your left hand and squeeze the brake lever bar with your right hand and push the lever bar forwards or pull it backwards to the persons required seat depth.

The seat width can be changed by pulling the Pull Pin





Pull the Right Hand brake lever to release the Tilt in Space gas strut and tilt the client towards you. As this is a manual chair you will need to help control the movement and push down the handles.

To bring the chair back up again release the brake lever and tilt the chair forward helping to control the movment.

Pull the Left Hand brake lever to release the Backrest gas strut and recline the Backrest towards you. As this is a manual chair you will need to help control the movement and push down the handles.

To bring the chair Backrest up again release the brake lever and lift upwards helping to control the movment.













Adjustable Seat Depth

(First apply the brakes)

You can change the seat depth from 17" to 21". To change the seat depth, lift the velcroed down skirt up at the back of the chair and you will see the brake lever on the backrest bar. Hold the lower bar with your left hand and squeeze the brake lever bar with your right hand and push the lever bar forwards or pull it backwards to the persons required seat depth.


